






Global Energy Demand





















LNG Exports Boosting Gas Demand

Shale Gas and Manufacturing Growth


- 294 new chemical industry projects due to shale gas planned, totaling \$179 billion in new capital investment
- 104 of these projects are in Texas totaling \$51 billion






